Instructions for Gas Gas Skid Plate









- Using a 5mm Allen wrench, remove the two front bolts holding on the stock plastic skid plate. (Fig 1)
- Position the new EE skid plate so that the front bolt holes align with the factory tabs (the same tabs the stock plastic skid plate attached to). Using the two supplied 8x25mm flathead bolts fasten the EE skid plate to the existing frame tabs (only finger tighten at this time) (Fig 2)
- While working from the right side of the motorcycle, position the rear mounting bar (part # 041-02) on the top side of the shock linkage mount. (Fig 3)
- While holding mounting bar in position, insert the supplied 8x55mm flathead bolt into the rear mounting hole of the EE skid plate.
- Press the skid plate up against the frame, and the 8x55mm bolt through the linkage mount and thread into the mounting bar (only finger tighten at this time) (Fig 4)
- Once all three mounting bolts have been started, use a 5mm Allen wrench and begin to tighten the mounting bolts, alternating from front to back until skid plate is secure.
